The ISI's [Quarter 3 Statistical Report](#) for 2018 has been published today.

Key statistics for Quarter 3 2018

- 771 New Applications
- 418 Protective Certificates
- 305 Arrangements approved
- 64 Bankruptcies

Commenting on the statistical report, Mr. Lorcan O'Connor, Director of the ISI, said

“The number of debtors securing Personal Insolvency Arrangements (the solution that returns debtors to solvency while keeping them in their home in over 95% of cases), is up 60% compared to the equivalent quarter in 2017. I encourage anyone with serious debt issues to consult a Personal Insolvency Practitioner or an Approved Intermediary, details of which are available on www.backontrack.ie or by calling 076 106 4200.
